Specialists

- A minimum of 7 years judging experience in the breed and have the support of the Scottish Siberian Husky Club.
- To have judged a minimum of 30 classes of this breed at, at least 5 open or champ shows without challenge certificates, with an adequate geographical spread.
- To have judged a minimum of 70 dogs in this breed.
- To have owned the breed for a minimum of 7 years and bred and/or owned a minimum of 3 dogs when they obtained their first entry in the kennel club stud book (save under exceptional circumstances)
- To have attended at least one Siberian Husky club seminar, run in accordance with the relevant kennel club code of best practice and passed an examination and/or assessment where applicable. (a3 assessment)
- Must have attended a Seminar on the Requirements of a Dog Show Judge delivered by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and passed the relevant exam This may be done online..
- To have attended a seminar given by a kennel club accredited trainer on conformation and movement.
- To have attended and passed "points of the dog" assessment conducted by a kennel club accredited trainer.
- To have stewarded for 12 full days.

Non-Specialists

- Minimum of 7 years judging experience in any 1 breed (to include 5 years in this breed) and have the support of the Scottish Siberian Husky Club.
- To have judged a minimum of 30 classes of this breed at, at least, 5 open or champ shows without challenge certificates, with an adequate geographical spread.
- To have judged a minimum of 70 dogs in this breed.
- To have awarded challenge certificates in at least one other breed.
- To have attended at least one Siberian Husky Club judging seminar, run in accordance with the relevant kennel club code of best practice and passed an examination and/or assessment where applicable. (a3 assessment)
- To have bred and/or owned a minimum of 3 dogs of any breed when they obtained their first entry in the kc stud book (save under exceptional circumstances).
- To have stewarded for 12 full days.
