## LEVEL 3

### Requirements to meet this level

To undergo a minimum of three mentoring sessions with a minimum of 12 months between the first and third session. <i>Mentoring sessions are arranged by the breed BEC, simply contact them to request.</i>	
<b>Venue and Type</b>	<b>Date completed</b>

Be observed judging a breed club show, breed supported entry show or championship show without CC's. <i>The number of dogs that need to be present is dependent upon the stud band of the breed in question. Siberian Huskies are Tier 3. Observations are arranged by the breed BEC, simply contact them to request.</i>
